SETUP TIME

- Booths may be set up as early as 4:30 p.m. on Friday at Mansfield Park. We will not have security so you will be responsible for your own items. There is a camp ground on the premises and there will be someone there to check you in if you wish to stay there. There are rest rooms and showers.
- Gates will open at 6:30 a.m. for early set up.
- Your space will be marked on the ground. Please stay within your space and do not set up in the walkways.
- You must be ready to sell by 9:00 a.m. as the Bike Rally will begin taking registrations at that time. There will be a taco breakfast for the bikers and they will have tacos for sale. We will provide free coffee for the vendors. Gates for the Hog Catch open at 10:00 am. Your vehicle must be out of the vending area by 8:45 am.

VEHICLE PARKING

- There is plenty of parking at Mansfield Park. You will be able to park within walking distance of your vehicle.

TRASH

- We will have a dumpster right outside the north end gate of the rodeo arena. Please put your trash in the dumpster and do not use the 55 gallon drums left for our visitors.

ICE

- There will be ice for sale on the grounds. If you a vendor and need ice, we require you purchase you ice from the Library at the beer booth.

BOOTH SPACES/TABLES/CHAIRS

- Booth spaces are 10x10. We do not provide tables or chairs. This event is outdoors and a tent or canopy is suggested.

BOOTH BREAKDOWN

- Please do not breakdown your booth before the event is over at 6:00 pm. Early breakdown will not be allowed unless bad weather occurs. The arrangement of the grounds does not allow for a vehicle to come inside during the event without posing safety risks.
